## FROM THE COMMANDER

Dear Bandit Parents, Family Members, and Friends:

I am Captain Richard Miller, your Soldier's Battery Commander for Basic Combat Training (BCT) in the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 31<sup>st</sup> Field Artillery, 434<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery Brigade, Fort Sill, Oklahoma. This is a detailed list of the states effected by the REAL ID Act enacted after 9/11.

## REAL ID BASE ACCESS FOR FORT SILL BCT FAMILY/GRADUATION DAY

- 1. Passed by Congress in 2005, the REAL ID Act enacted the 9/11 Commission's recommendation that the Federal Government "set standards for the issuance of sources of identification, such as driver's licenses." The Act established minimum security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards and prohibits Federal agencies from accepting for official purposes licenses and identification cards from states that do not meet these standards.
- 2. The following states are listed as Compliant States with the REAL ID Act and will not need additional identification:
